## Observations etc.

- Response time to initial ignition (Total Fire Ban day, proximity of Hernes Oak fire
- Access from West to Open Cut and state of Open Cut fire breaks
- Cognisance and attention to "Principles' of fire protection to Open Cuts and surrounds, including rehabilitation

(see Yallourn Open Cut History) – as defined by Forestry Officer and subsequently reviewed by Jack A. Vines 1966, and after 1977 Fire Inquiry. Also Bob Odgers)

NB: Yallourn Open Cut – table page 213. 100 – 400 /year (obviously requiring prompt attention, by adequately trained staff.

*At privatization* – what advice to new owners and what responsibilities for Government Body to monitor.
