THIS PROVIDED A DIFECT PATHWAY INTO THE TOWNSHIP OF MORWELL AND THE COMMUNITY OF HEARNES OAK, INCLUDING THE OPEN CUT MINE.

IT IS CRUCIAL THAT

THIS OVERSIGHT IS BETTER MANAGED IN FUTURE,

AN ADDED

CONCERN IS THE CLOSE PROXIMITY OF WOOD PLANTATIONS WHICH SUPPORT THE A.P.M.

PLANTATIONS ARE VITAL TO THE MILLS OPERATIONS, FURTHER THOUGHT AND PLANNING NEEDS TO GO INTO THEIR LOCATION, IT MAY BE PRUDENT TO CONSIDER A WIDENING OF THE BUFFER ZONES TO SEPERATE PLANTATIONS FROM RESIDENTIAL LIVING, COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND OPEN CUT MINES.
