## Submission to the Hazelwood Mine Inquiry

On the 25<sup>th</sup> April I went by bus into Morwell. I arrived in mid morning to attend to business I had in Morwell (as many from the district have to do). There was low smoke visible everywhere and the smell of smoke was strong.

I walked from the bus station to George Street and felt grit get in my eye. I thought to myself – "The grit in the air is worse than Bangkok" – I had just returned from Bangkok the previous Thursday so I was very aware of the conditions there.

Ever since that day I have had a sore right eye. It is inflamed and red. I cannot prove that the condition is directly related to the fire but I believe the risks of carcinogenic and toxic matter impacting on Morwell & District resident's health was much higher than has been acknowledged by Public Health officers, and the Precautionary Principle should have been applied with at least Health warnings posted & preferably a general evacuation and closure of Morwell from public access during the course of the fire.

My story is not isolated, I have spoken to many who feel that they have suffered health issues as a consequence of the fire.
