Just to let you know that an out of control Fire is in progress in the Hernes Oak area (across the Highway from Yallourn). The incident was reported to have started just after 1500hrs and is moving along fairly rapidly. There are several CFA appliances in attendance but it is not under control.

Initially the fire direction was such that it was heading in the Hazelwood direction. The Mine is on alert and additional water spraying has been occurring and spotting teams have been deployed. The fire has however turned toward the Yallourn direction. The Highway is now closed due to smoke.

Currently there is no threat to the Hazelwood business. There are infrared cameras installed to detect intrusions of the sit and they are currently used to monitor potential hot spots.
