

HERNES OAK FIRE

DOOR KNOCK KEY MESSAGES

The Hernes Oak fire is still burning along McDonalds track and Crowes road and Witts Track area.

Emergency services are expecting severe weather conditions overnight and early into Sunday Morning.

There is expected thunderstorm activity for tonight. Strong easterly winds are expected into the early morning of Sunday. This may increase fire activity. This fire could jump control lines and impact this area overnight.

The Fire danger rating for Sunday is Extreme and Total Fire Ban.

If the fire begins it will impact on private property very quickly.

This might happen overnight.

When fires impact on homes at night it is extremely dangerous. Families get disoriented and confused in these conditions.

Roads into and out of the area may be affected by fire overnight and possibly blocked.

In order to inform you early, and avoid contacting you in the middle of the night we are advising communities now and suggesting that they should consider leaving the area tonight before midnight.

Relief Centre will be open from 6pm at Moe Town Hall on Albert Street, Moe.
