SUBJECT: School and Early Childhood closures due to impact of fires

Summary

Update on impact of Schools and Early Childhood Centres in the rural area of SEVR

It is pleasing to note that the number of Schools and Early Childhood Centres are now returning to normal. There are still some bus route closures which are listed below.

As there continues to be smoke in many areas of Victoria, please continue to monitor the EPA's air quality report at: <u>www.epa.vic.gov.au/our-work/monitoring-the-environment/air-guality-bulletins.</u> Students with asthma, should be utilizing their Asthma Plan.

Support Services

Water Tanks

Please continue to monitor your water tanks to ensure a clean supply of drinking water is available following the fires over the past week and for those schools in areas where fires are still active.

A number of schools have rainwater tanks for drinking water. It is important that schools check this supply for ash contamination.

Schools should check and clean the roof catchment area, roof gutters and downpipes to ensure that these components are clean and that no ash enters the drinking supply.

If the drinking water is found to be contaminated then schools should immediately arrange for the roof area, gutters and tank to be cleaned out and water replaced immediately.

Schools are to arrange and pay for this work in the first instance and advise Peter Trevena or Kevin O'Rourke at the Regional office. The region will arrange reimbursement of the cost of this water supply maintenance.

The following schools and Early Childhood Centres are closed today:

- Goongerah/Tubbut P-8 school (both campuses) will be closed until 14 February
- Goongerah ELC

School Buses

If a bus route is to be closed, or if a route is to remain closed, this must be confirmed to Kevin O'Rourke at <u>orourke.kevin.j@edumail.vic.gov.au</u>, SEVR Dandenong Regional office by **2.00pm each day.** Please take into account all local information and utilize the VicRoads website. Where possible, confirmation of road conditions should be validated with your local police.

Bus coordinators are to ensure that all parents are notified and that other users travelling on that route are also notified accordingly of any cancellation.
