- Goongerah and Martins Creek. Fire Origin: 6KM NW OF GOONGERAH. Incident Name: GOONGERAH-MT JERSEY
- Alberton, Calrossie, Devon North, Glen Rose, Greenmount, Macks Creek, Whitelaw, Won Wron, Woranga, Yarram. Fire Origin: Madayla. Incident Name: EGANS RD.

Recommendation to Evacuate is in place for:-

- Bonang, Cabanandra, Deddick Valley, Dellicknora, Tubbut and Amboyne, to go to Delegate Relief Centre at the Delegate Country Club, Bonang Road, Delegate.
- Bete Bolong, Bete Bolong North, Youngs Creek and the outlying areas of Jarrahmond to go to the Orbost Relief Centre at Orbost Secondary College, Arnold Street, Orbost.
- Goongerah or Martins Creek to go to the Relief Centre at the Orbost Secondary College Assembly Hall.

Traralgon ICC

New Fire - Yarram - Jack River - Egans Road.

- Westerly wind is pushing this fire to the north of Yarram towards Woodside. Yarram is not expected to be impacted.
- Warnings and Advice messaging is in place.
- Ember attack is reported in Won Wron.

Hernes Oak - McDonalds Track fire

- This fire has escaped and is running parallel with the freeway and railway towards Morwell, in between the Coal mine.
- Reports that this fire is now spotting into the Hazellwood Power station.
- There is possible fire in the coal mine. The Traralgon ICC is working on this.

Road Closures

• It was identified that we can't continue diverting traffic through Yallourn North due to the current fire activity in this area, and we can no longer use the South Gippsland Highway. We may need to block the highway at Traralgon and Trafalgar.

Bairnsdale ICC

Timbarra - Gil Groggin

- Able to maintain this fire on the hill for now. The peak of the Gil Groggin hill has protected the fire from the wind. Not anticipating the large run into Buchan that was predicted earlier. It may move under the south westerly winds.
- Evacuation Warnings for Buchan are being maintained as a precaution.

Orbost ICC

 The Fire Behaviour Predictive Map that was circulated earlier today showed that Mallacoota could have been impacted, but this has been scaled back because the fire did not commence running as early as expected.

Orbost - Wombat Creek

- This fire is running towards the Highway.
- Evacuation plans are in place for Waygara, east of Nowa Nowa.
- This fire is spotting 7km ahead of the fire.
- Spotting 1km north of Orbost. Crew have been tasked to these fires.

Club Terrace Complex

- This fire has left containment lines at Purple Patch.
- Club Terrace has been evacuated all except 3 households have evacuated.
- Messaging is encouraging residents to leave now while it is safe to do so.

	Goongerah – Deddick Trail (formerly Snowy Complex) This fire has produced a huge column of smoke and is producing 7km spotting ahead of the fire.
