CLASSIFICATION

- (M) major accidents and incidents (including environmental incidents) and complaints of an urgent nature
- (S) significant incidents (including environmental incidents) and complaints relating to specific sites, client or customer issues.
- (Minor) minor accidents and incidents (including environmental incidents) and complaints about general issues

Major (Class M) accidents and incidents and complaints are defined as (but not limited to) incidents or complaints resulting in:death.

- permanent disability
- loss of body function, not resulting from a previously held medical condition
- · acute exposure to toxic substances (including spills)
- burns to 10% or more of the body
- serious injuries including those resulting in concussion or loss of consciousness
- · temporary or permanent loss of sight
- any injury resulting in hospitalisation beyond routine observation
- hydrocarbon releases in excess of 500lt, spillage of Dangerous Goods
- · structural damage resulting in the need for extensive repairs
- spills resulting in environmental contamination on mining or EL sites likely to effect areas outside the lease/ licence area
- obstruction, assault etc of inspectors or Departmental / Divisional representatives
- · incidents attracting media attention or involvement

Significant (Class S) incidents that have the potential for serious consequences eg:

- · exposure to hazardous substances that could result in ill effects to people or the environment
- incidents involving classified or designated plant (under the Dangerous Goods Act) resulting in damage that prevents safe operation
- allegations of discrimination against the elected Health and Safety representative or other employees
- non- complied with directions, PINS or
- complaints from third parties relating to specific breaches of licence or permit conditions or general nuisance

Minor (Class Minor) incidents or complaints are defined as:

- any other event reported by the operator/ contractor to member of the public hat is not classified above
- near misses

PRIORITY

Class A: Site investigation has to be carried out without any delay

Class B: Site investigation and report should be carried out at the first available opportunity
Class C: Record incident. Do not investigate unless required, seek a report from the operator
