## ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE FOR PRIMARY PRODUCERS AND SMALL BUSINESSES AFFECTED BY FEBRURY 2014 BUSHFIRES

The Minister for Justice Michael Keenan and the Victorian Minister for Police and Emergency Services and Minister for Bushfire Response Kim Wells today announced that low-interest concessional loans have now been made available to eligible primary producers, small businesses and not-for-profit organisations affected by the February 2014 bushfires.

"Disaster assistance for these fires is being provided under the jointly-funded Commonwealth and State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements to primary producers, small businesses and not-for-profit organisations," Mr Keenan said.

Mr Wells said that concessional interest rate loans are being made available to bushfire-affected small businesses and primary producers in the local government areas of Baw Baw, East Gippsland, Greater Shepparton, Hume, Latrobe, Macedon Ranges, Manningham, Mitchell, Moira, Nillumbik, Wellington and Yarra Ranges.

Concessional loans of up to \$200,000 will be administered by the Rural Finance Corporation of Victoria and can be used to restore damaged buildings, replace damaged equipment and stock and for other general requirements to assist businesses.

"I encourage all primary producers and small businesses who have suffered direct physical impact from the February bushfires to contact the Rural Finance Corporation to test their eligibility for the loans," Mr Wells said.
