Purpose for entry:

I entered this place to follow up on matters dealt with at a previous visit.

Under section 98(1) of the Occupational Health and Safety Act 2004, I entered your workplace during working hours.

Observations and Actions of the inspector

1. OHS-0274: Follow up notice I visited the workplace to follow up on a visit I conducted on the 05/03/12.

The employer has made some progress in moving towards the moving and repair of the D11 dredger,

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At the time of this visit the Action Plan that has been developed for removing the discharge boom from the dredger were provided. Lend Lease is the contractor that is managing this process.

Lend Lease has developed Safe Work Method Statements (SWMS) for the shoring up off the tower structure, erecting scaffolding and inserting 20t pins underneath the discharge boom structure to assist with the removal of the boom from the dredger. SWMS 009 has been revised to include all hazards associated with scaffold works. The contractor has also revised the incident Reporting Procedure to ensure that the reporting process is defined. The structural integrity of these structures has been assessed and is sufficient for this work to commence. The work will commence next week.

Once the discharge boom has been removed further assessment of the structure will be undertaken to ensure that it is stable for moving the dredger to the pad for repair works to commence. The employer has agreed to provide continuous updates to WorkSafe Victoria at each stage of this process.

The continued progress of the employer in the management of this issue will be monitored as the process progresses.
