Item 2: Actions from Meeting #10 – 10 March 2015

Actions:

- Lessons learned from the fire season to be incorporated for planning purposes at the mid year Municipal Fire Committee Planning meeting. This action to be held over until the next meeting, 6 May 2015.
- EMC met with Chief Officers regarding Operationalising CO and Smoke protocols. (See attached spreadsheet).
 - The objective is to develop a comprehensive and sector-wide training framework that supports the 'detection, analysis and management of smoke and an atmospheric strategy'.
 - o There is already a large amount of training material and programs in place that we can use as a foundation to build on.
 - We are attempting to capture the learnings from Hazelwood and other events, transmit and share these learnings across the sector. We have focused on formal training in this session and we can also utilise other methods such as case studies to inform and share these lessons.
- The Aircraft contract arrangements are about to expire. FLIR flight conducted 14 April and are to be reviewed at the end of the month and CFA will make some decisions regarding ongoing and frequency of flights.
- EMC met with DELWP Chief Officer to discuss approvals of fuel reduction burning within 70km radius of La Trobe Valley, current arrangements will be left in place until after the burn season and reviewed in May.

CFA • 1 April 2015 Minister Garrett officially launched the CFA new District 27. • Working towards a new direction of building community connections. **DHHS (Health)** Linkages between Health and EPA messaging being investigated to ensure commonality of approach regarding community messaging and education. **DHHS (Recovery)** Responsibility for recovery has been handed over to LCC. • TFD and DHHS to arrange presentation to RMF re: Taskforce activities and direction. **EPA** Updating implementation recommendations, following on from Hazelwood recommendations.

- Emily has been taken offline to do some strategic work around all the different works EPA is doing within the region.
- Air quality monitoring is gearing up for rapid response network that is to be up and running for next fire season.
- Two new air monitoring stations turned on at Churchill and Moe.
- Focus has been on planned burns, a couple days of smoke around the La Trobe Valley pushed the air quality readings to poor and very poor, which resulted in a different level of response including over night monitoring.
- Mobile technology was implemented for 5 days when one of the monitoring units failed.
- A Community reference group in the Valley is to being set up focusing on air monitoring and broader environment issues.

DEDJTR

- Nothing further to previously reported.
- Discussion held regarding communication protocols within Government.

AGL

- New CAFS Unit arriving shortly
- A mine and wildfire training exercise was held 26 March 2015 with impressive results, all staff successfully managing their roles.

GDF SUEZ

- Recent 'familiarisation exercise' held at the mine. There is a new plan and system in place.
- A visit from the implementation monitor is scheduled.
- Significant progress has been made, aiming to have the recommendations implemented in six weeks.

Energy Australia

- Work continuing with additional pipe works, rehabilitation and upgrading the wall on the high level dam.
- GHD are facilitating workshops for the new 'Risk management and fire plan' in conjunction with the three mines and agency groups. The second workshop is being held 17 April 2015. TFD attending and CFA OM Bill Johnstone to be invited.
