- Community Connections Workshop organised for 6 May 2015 1730 -1930hrs at Morwell Bowling Club. Trusted network and Principal community leaders were invited.
- Communication with agencies on evidence collection prior to 30 June 2015 to be actioned by TFD.

Legislation changes – Implementation of Risk Based work Plan

- Commencement date of amendments to legislation to bring in risk based work plans is to be brought forward to 31 December 2015 **on track**.
- o Amendment of regulations to be consistent with risk based work plan requirements on track
- o Preparation of a regulatory impact statement on track
- Working together:
 - o Worksafe
 - MOU between Worksafe and DEDJTR has been written and signatures are being obtained
 - Two verifications (Worksafe lead) and three Audits (DEDJTR lead) have been undertaken together.
 - o EPA
 - MOU between EPA and DEDJTR has been written and signatures are being obtained
 - Joint audits for Dust have been undertaken at all three mines in Latrobe Valley.

EMC

- Need to use the timelines given by the Implementation Monitor team
- Need to be practical over the next few months getting recommendations 11 & 12 implemented.

Taskforce

- Joined Standardisation Committee (CGEIG Sub Committee)
- Partaking in joint mines Risk Analysis process workshops.
- Presentation on Taskforce status and achievements delivered to CFA Operations Conference. Nick Demetrious (AGL) delivered presentation at same conference.

CFA

- Works being done on the development of the Brown Coal fire fighter training package
- Video training packages Statewide.
- Aircraft contract has ended. Monitoring to start approximately October.

DHHS (Health)

 Holding consultations with stakeholders on 8 May around establishing a Latrobe health conservation zone & establish a coadvocate.

LCC

- Putting together the Hazardous materials release sub plan
- Risk assessment came up high, looking at forming a sub committee with EPA & CFA

LCC (Community Resilience team)

- CRC is still in place, looking at transitioning from a recovery committee to a resilience committee
- Running a pilot project for the community, information from the community with the goal of producing a Emergency Plan targeting the community of Morwell, south of Commercial Rd and west of Hazelwood Rd.

EPA

- About to launch into some significant Community consultation in relation to 12months of monitoring post Hazelwood Mine fire. Results are in and are now asking community for input.
- Recently launched a Social network Analysis, largely led by DHHS around communicating with the community. Need to ensure it aligns with the Community Connection workshops.
- Some significant deliverables are concluding in the next couple of months.

- Concluded 12mths of testing showing no lasting impacts on air, water or land as a result of the fire. Still need to validate it with the community and go through a few more steps. The 3 monthly data around that is on the EPA website.
- Postponed the Smoke monitoring exercise around testing the rapid response, due to the other issues in March. Looking at a Statewide exercise in time to be prepared for the next fire season.
- Talking to 'Voices of the Valley' re communicating with the community
- Winding up the pilot Citizen science project
- Reviewing rapid response protocol
- Completed inspections of each of the mines to look for dust mitigation issues.

AGL

- CAFS truck should be here next week followed by 2 weeks of training and then brought online. Keen to do a public launch thereafter.
- Several million dollars have been allocated to areas of improvements.
- An old hotspot is being monitored.

GDF SUEZ

- Positive outcomes with the Implementation Monitor team visit. Almost at the conclusion of the affirmations and recommendations implementation.
- Next phase is giving the community the confidence the mines have taken serious steps to ensure the mines capability and preparedness to approach the upcoming fire seasons.
